



Student Pastor Job Description

The Student Pastor will be responsible for leading and growing the Hope Students ministry for students grades 5 to 12. The Students Pastor will have a dynamic ability to attract and engage students in relevant ways that help grow a faith of their own.

Primary Responsibilities

- Cast the vision for the win and expectations of the Hope Student ministry
- Recruit, train and lead Hope Student volunteers that align with the Hope Church mission and values
- Develop and implement curriculum that helps students grow in their faith and its application to their life
- Equip parents as the primary influence in the spiritual growth of their students
- Implement and maintain ongoing communications with students and parents (email, social media, etc.)
- Play an active role in students' life during the week, attending games, plays and other extracurricular activities of students
- Plan and execute weekly student

Requirements

The Student Pastor must be able to skillfully execute the following:

- Recruit and develop new Student volunteers while providing ongoing training and support for current volunteers
- Be an active part of Hope Church—participating in a Hope Group, present at Sunday morning services, attend Hope Church staff meetings and actively embedded into the Hope culture.
- Serve as part of the preaching team at Hope Church.
- This role reports to the Director of Staff

Qualifications

- Hold a Bachelor's degree in Bible, theology, youth or related field.
- Experience in youth ministry is encouraged.
- Detailed knowledge, agreement, and adherence to the Hope Church mission, vision and values
- Self-motivated and organized with the ability to build, engage and lead a team of volunteers
